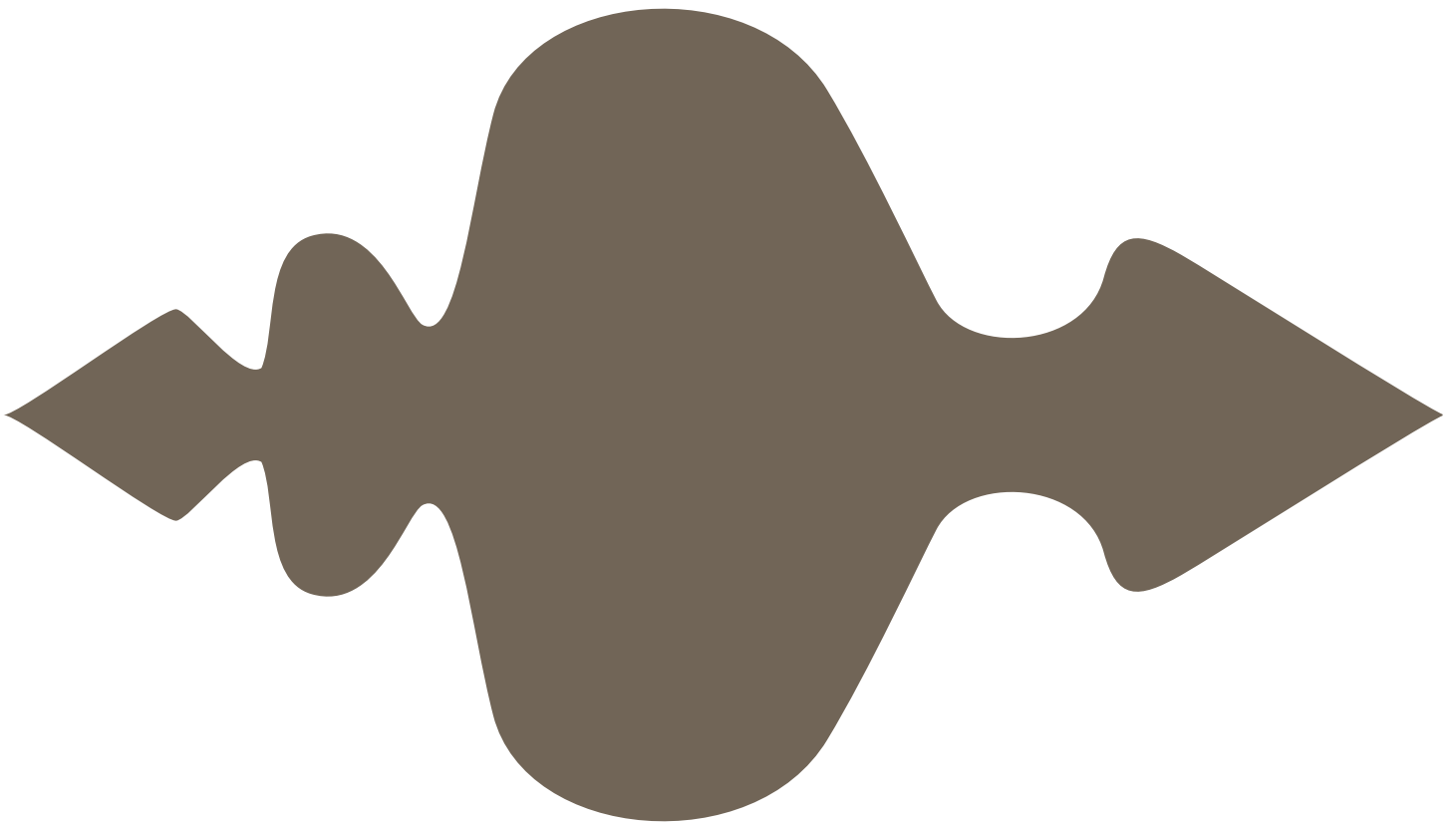
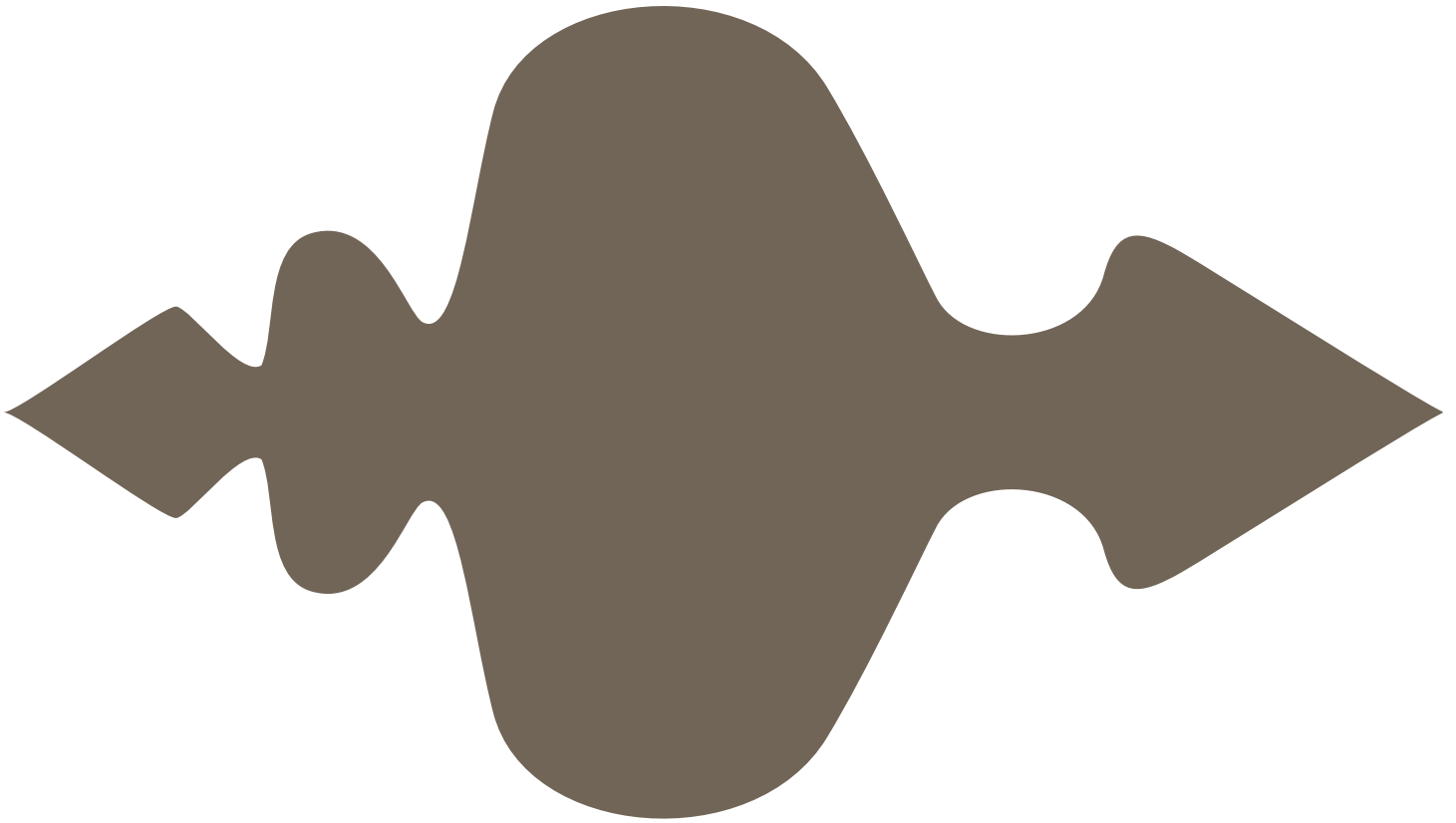


a 1001 night ornament - the front side...

Do like this: print and cut a number of the shapes, and fold them very neatly down the center. I use a sharp steel ruler to help me! Use fast drying glue and glue the first two folds neatly together. Then glue a loop of string of your choice exactly down the middle. Let bits dry between 'glueings'...! Then add - one by one - the folded shapes to form a fabulous 3D shape. Merry Christmas...!



About printing this PDF:

Set your printer to print only **page one** first, 100% size. Print 3, 4 or perhaps 5 copies, depending on how filled you want the design. Then take your prints, flip them, and refeed them into the printer, blank backsides up /out (I always use the handfeed tray).

See the arrows on 'back side' for feeding direction! Now you are ready to print **page two**, 100% size (- and set number of copies).

Voilà - lovely color on both sides of your cutout shapes!
