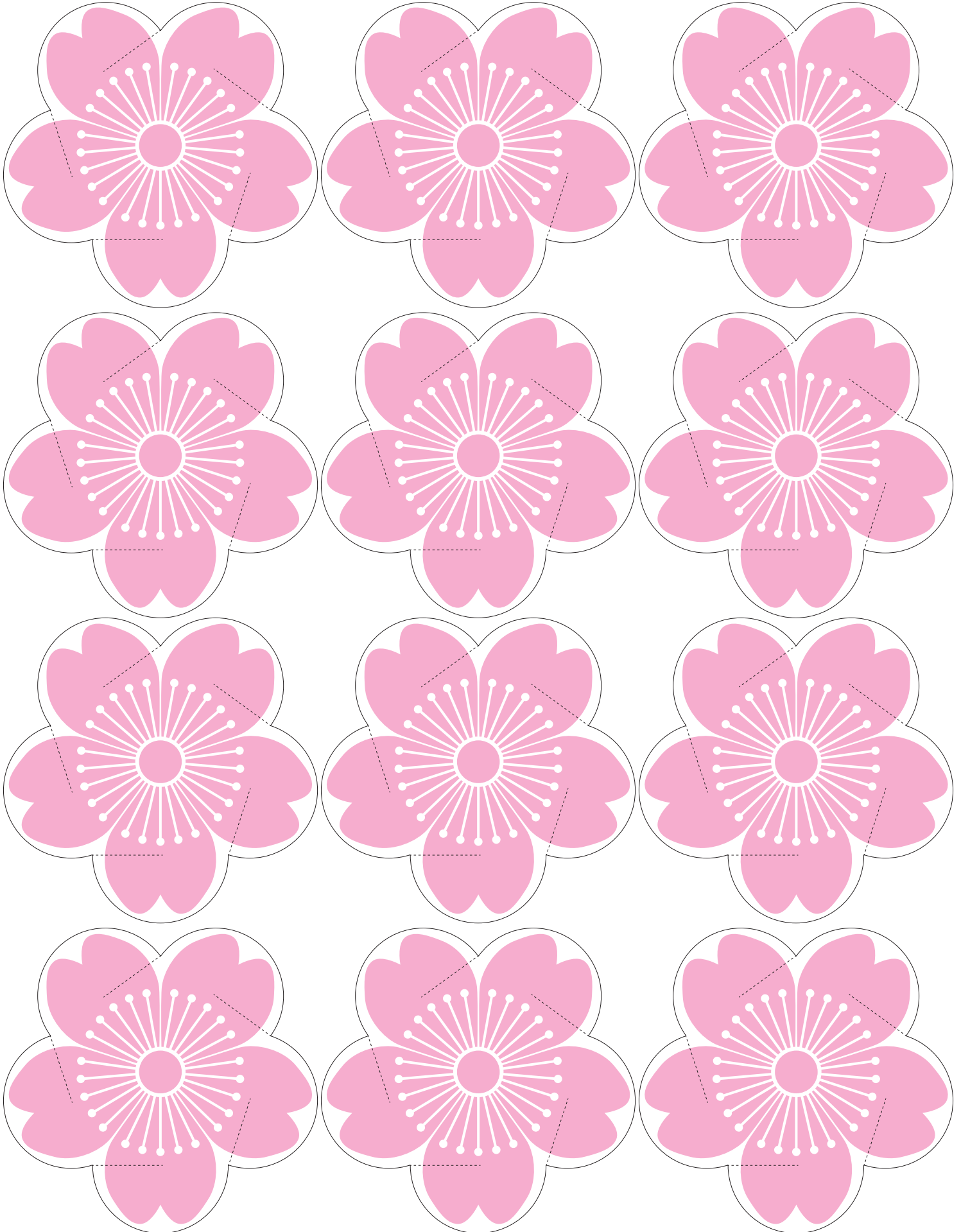


# Cherry Blossom Flowerballs / style # 1

Print both sides (see page 2 for tips). They work well on slightly heavier paper (100-120 gsm), if you have it. Cut out all petals (12 petals make one ball), and the slits marked with dotted lines. Assemble the flowerballs by 'hingeing' the petals together. It's easy, and makes sense when you do it! Before securing the last petal, fasten the string inside with a bit of tape or make a big knot, to prevent it from slipping out.



# Cherry Blossom Flowerballs / style # 1

Page 2 (back side) - print both sides like this:

Set your printer to print ONLY page 1 in the desired number of prints.

Then take your prints and turn them over and upside down (note the feeding direction of your printer) and print ONLY page 2, this time. Voilà!
